Questions to ask yourself before starting with agile project management

<input type="checkbox"/> Is the agile approach suitable for my project?	<i>Circumstances that make this difficult can be if the project is based on a fixed contract or if changes are expensive.</i>	See Chapter 8.
<input type="checkbox"/> Can the project team achieve the right size and composition?	<i>Each project team should ideally have five to nine members with a range of competencies, to be able to perform most of the project work on their own, without needing too much help from other parts of the organization.</i>	See Chapter 3.
<input type="checkbox"/> Would an agile project work for my suppliers and others involved?	<i>Favourable circumstances are if the project has complex goals and its surroundings are prone to change.</i>	See Chapter 3 on Roles and Chapter 4 on the stakeholder analysis.
